

Job Title:

Psychiatrist: Warrior Transition Unit (05 to 06 billet)

Job Description:

This individual will lead the Warrior in Transition Treatment Team offering full spectrum mental health care to Warriors in Transition. This team which includes Psychologists and Social Workers will operate out of the behavioral health clinic but will interact with our WTU Clinics and resources including Occupational Therapy and the WTU SW services as well. The purpose of this initiative is to provide more integrated care from a focused team. The Psychiatrist will serve as the team leader and would be the primary rater for the other team members. Total team size will be 3-5 providers depending on the level of need. Additionally this provider will be responsible for assisting in writing of fitness for duty evaluations including Medical Evaluation Boards (MEBs).

Requirements:

License: A current, unrestricted, and valid medical license from a U.S. State, District of Columbia, Commonwealth, Territory, or other jurisdiction is required.

Training: A candidate must possess a qualifying Doctor of Medicine (M.D.) or Doctor of Osteopathic Medicine (D.O.) degree from a medical school that is accredited by the Council on Medical Education of the American Medical Association or Bureau of Professional Education, Committee on Colleges of the American Osteopathic Association, respectively. However, candidates who are graduates of medical schools that are not located in a U.S. State, District of Columbia, Commonwealth, Territory or other jurisdiction, or a Province or Territory of Canada, may be appointed if they are certified by the Educational Commission for Foreign Medical Graduates and meet all other requirements for appointment.

Minimum 3 year commitment.
