Social Worker: Traumatic Brain Injury Program (O4 to O5 billet)

**Job Description:**

Requires the application of specialized clinical knowledge and advanced clinical skills in the areas of prevention, assessment, diagnosis and treatment of mental, emotional, and other behavioral disorders. Skilled in evidence-based treatment methods applied to the provision of individual, marital, family, and group psychotherapy. The clinical providers should possess specific interest, training, education, and skills in addressing the sequelae of traumatic brain injury in a specialized patient population. Is a member of a multi-disciplinary team providing clinical services, information and referral, psycho-educational groups and briefings to commanders and to various target patients, family members, and specified organizations.

**Requirements:**

License: A current, valid, unrestricted, registration or certification that allows for independent clinical social work practice in a U.S. State is required.

Training: The candidate must possess a qualifying master's degree in social work that has been accredited by the Council on Social Work Education.

Minimum 3 year commitment.
