

**Job Title:**

Emergency Department Social Worker (05 to 06 Billet)

**Job Description:**

Oversee a brand new initiative to provide Social Work staff in the ED 24/7. This would include ensuring that providers screen soldiers and family members for (as needed) mental health intervention, physical abuse or neglect, and/or sexual assault. Position would entail supervising 6 GS11 LCSW social workers and 2 Social Service Assistants. It would also include care coordination with ED staff. This position is for a PHS officer (04 to 06 rank). It is part of the DoD/HHS Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) which allows PHS officers to be detailed to the DoD in support of the DoD's Psychological Health Mission. PHS officers are required to serve 3 years in the position before a PCS. PHS officers will be subject to the Uniform Code of Military Justice (UCMJ). Applicants are required to have their independent clinical social work license (LCSW).

**Requirements:**

License: A current, valid, unrestricted, registration or certification that allows for independent clinical social work practice in a U.S. State is required.

Training: The candidate must possess a qualifying master's degree in social work that has been accredited by the Council on Social Work Education.

**Location Description:**

Womack Army Medical Center Fort Bragg, North Carolina is an Army Military Treatment Facility (MTF) located approximately 3 hours east of Charlotte, North Carolina. It serves active duty military personnel and their families.
