

Job Title:

Family Advocacy Program Social Worker - 2 positions (05 to 06 Billet)

Job Description:

Therapist and case manager in 2nd largest Department of Social Work in the Army with over 100 new cases of adult and child abuse/neglect a month. Also offers counseling and runs therapeutic groups. This position is for a PHS officer (O4 to O6 rank). It is part of the DoD/HHS Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) which allows PHS officers to be detailed to the DoD in support of the DoD's Psychological Health Mission. PHS officers are required to serve 3 years in the position before a PCS. PHS officers will be subject to the Uniform Code of Military Justice (UCMJ). Applicants are required to have their independent clinical social work license (LCSW).

Requirements:

License: A current, valid, unrestricted, registration or certification that allows for independent clinical social work practice in a U.S. State is required.

Training: The candidate must possess a qualifying master's degree in social work that has been accredited by the Council on Social Work Education.

Location Description:

Womack Army Medical Center Fort Bragg, North Carolina is an Army Military Treatment Facility (MTF) located approximately 3 hours east of Charlotte, North Carolina. It serves active duty military personnel and their families.
