

**Job Title:**

Sexual Assault Care Coordinator Social Worker (05 to 06 Billet)

**Job Description:**

This position is for a senior level social worker (LCSW) with training in sexual assault. The officer will be responsible for data management and counseling for all sexual assault victims at Ft. Bragg. This includes working with the nursing staff responsible for care of these victims and sexual assault program manager. This is a DOD initiative and mandated program. This position is for a PHS officer (05 to 06 rank). It is part of the DoD/HHS Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) which allows PHS officers to be detailed to the DoD in support of the DoD's Psychological Health Mission. PHS officers are required to serve 3 years in the position before a PCS. PHS officers will be subject to the Uniform Code of Military Justice (UCMJ). Applicants are required to have their independent clinical social work license (LCSW).

**Requirements:**

License: A current, valid, unrestricted, registration or certification that allows for independent clinical social work practice in a U.S. State is required.

Training: The candidate must possess a qualifying master's degree in social work that has been accredited by the Council on Social Work Education.

**Location Description:**

Womack Army Medical Center Fort Bragg, North Carolina is an Army Military Treatment Facility (MTF) located approximately 3 hours east of Charlotte, North Carolina. It serves active duty military personnel and their families.
