

Job Title:

Psychiatrist (non-supervisory): Mental Health Department (04 to 06 billet)

Job Description:

Examines and diagnoses patients with mental illness. Treats severely mentally disturbed patients, as well as those with acute psychiatric issues that are chronic and complex. Monitors treatment effectiveness through evidence based medicine and individual treatment plans. Provides support to Fleet and Family Service Center. Works on multi-disciplinary teams comprised of primary care providers and other specialties and is a consultant to other clinical providers. Documents care using AHLTA, an electronic medical records program. Makes fitness and suitability for duty recommendations, including preparing Physical Evaluation Boards and Administrative Separation recommendations. All other duties as assigned.

Requirements:

License: A current, unrestricted, and valid medical license from a U.S. State, District of Columbia, Commonwealth, Territory, or other jurisdiction is required.

Training: A candidate must possess a qualifying Doctor of Medicine (M.D.) or Doctor of Osteopathic Medicine (D.O.) degree from a medical school that is accredited by the Council on Medical Education of the American Medical Association or Bureau of Professional Education, Committee on Colleges of the American Osteopathic Association, respectively. However, candidates who are graduates of medical schools that are not located in a U.S. State, District of Columbia, Commonwealth, Territory or other jurisdiction, or a Province or Territory of Canada, may be appointed if they are certified by the Educational Commission for Foreign Medical Graduates and meet all other requirements for appointment.

This position is for a minimum 3 year commitment.
