

**Job Title:**

Social Worker: Social Work Division 4 openings (04 to 05 billet)

**Job Description:**

The Officer will provide individual, couples, family and/or group psychotherapy to Active Duty military personnel, their dependents and retirees at the Naval Medical Center Portsmouth (NMCP) and/or one of the branch clinics located throughout the Hampton Roads area. Social workers may also provide services in the Psychiatric Intensive Outpatient Program (PIOP) or the Assessment, Stabilization, Evaluation and Treatment (ASET) Program, located at NMCP.

Other possibilities include psychiatric inpatient work or substance abuse treatment. Social workers will report to the Psychiatric Social Work Division Officer and may be given collateral duties to perform by the Division Officer or members of the Chain of Command consistent with the mental health mission. Administrative and/or leadership opportunities may be added to job duties. Social workers applying for positions at NMCP should be experienced and licensed independent practitioners whose careers have been mostly characterized by clinical duties. A strong desire to work in a military environment should be considered, however, prior military experience is not necessary.

**Requirements:**

License: A current, valid, unrestricted, registration or certification that allows for independent clinical social work practice in a U.S. State is required.

Training: The candidate must possess a qualifying master's degree in social work that has been accredited by the Council on Social Work Education.

Minimum 3 year commitment.
