

Job Title:

AIR FORCE: Clinical Psychologist - 75th Mental Health Flight-Hill Air Force Base, UT (O-5 billet, Non-Supervisory)

Job Responsibilities:

Evaluates and treats patients presenting to Mental Health Services. Provides individual, group, marital and family psychotherapy. Conducts commander directed evaluations with emphasis on Personnel Reliability Program, weapons, security clearance, flying status, and fitness for duty determinations. Conducts and interprets psychological testing, making therapeutic and administrative recommendations. Seeks appropriate consultation as needed. Informs other staff members of potentially high-risk and high-interest patients. Completes appropriate documentation in both the Mental Health, AHLTA, and outpatient records, as appropriate. Conducts neuropsychological testing, biofeedback, sex therapy and hypnosis, as credentialed. Provides consultative services to commanders on mental health-related issues. Focuses on prevention in the base community and community at large by giving seminars and/or briefings on mental health issues. Provides suicide, homicide, and mental status evaluations for distressed individuals, and makes appropriate treatment dispositions. Peer reviews work of other staff in Mental Health Services. Participates in quality improvement initiatives designed to enhance mental health services. Provides care within ethical and legal boundaries. Contributes to professional environment using appropriate leadership skills.

Maintains all basic readiness standards as required by the U.S. Public Health Service. Requires a Secret clearance.

PHS officers assigned under this Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) must remain available for PHS deployments. Under this MOA, PHS officers are not authorized to deploy with the military.

Requirements:

Graduation from an accredited graduate school, to include completion of residency training, with a PhD or Psy.D. in Clinical or Counseling Psychology. Current board certification is highly desirable. State licensure is mandatory. Additional training in Biofeedback, Sex Therapy, Neuropsychological Assessment, Pediatric Psychology, Hypnosis, or Health Psychology is desirable. Current training in Basic Life Support and Cardiopulmonary resuscitation is required. Must obtain required number of Continuing Education Unit hours to maintain state licensure and additional certifications.
