AIR FORCE: Clinical Psychologist - Malcolm Grow Medical Clinics and Surgery Center-Joint Base Andrews, MD (O-5 billet, Supervisory)

Job Description:

Primary role of this position is as a clinical psychologist or clinical health psychologist, dependent upon the qualifications of the applicant. Preference will be given to applicants with clinical health psychology experience. Performance expectations are as a frontline provider, maintaining a scheduled template of 5.5 hours of patient care per day. Supervisory responsibilities will be minimal and will involve supervising psychology and/or social work interns/residents as part of the Flight's training mission. Applicant may supervise 1-2 interns/residents; supervisory responsibilities will be considered part of the required clinical template. On-call responsibilities are minimal, totaling 4-5 weeks per year. On-call duties are conducted exclusively within the 779th Medical Group's Emergent Care Center. Emphasis in service delivery is on evidence-based treatment for various mental disorders. If the applicant is qualified, they may be assigned duties in the Behavioral Medicine Service, providing evidence-based evaluation and treatment services for patients across the full age spectrum with chronic medical conditions, psychophysiological disorders, and maladaptive health habits.

There are on-call responsibilities associated with this job announcement.

Maintains all basic readiness standards as required by the U.S. Public Health Service. Requires a Secret clearance.

PHS officers assigned under this Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) must remain available for PHS deployments. Under this MOA, PHS officers are not authorized to deploy with the military.

Requirements:

License: A doctoral degree(PhD or PsyD) in clinical/counseling psychology from an APA-accredited university or professional psychology school. A current, unrestricted, and valid psychologist license from a U.S. State (as defined in 42 USC 201 (f)) is required.

Additional Requirements:

Must possess knowledge of mental health processes; theories of personality development, human behavior, and psychopathology; and psychotherapy. Must have experience in providing assessments, evaluations, group and individual psychotherapy, and behavioral health consultation services. Post-doctoral training in Clinical Health Psychology preferred. Initial assignment term is a 3-year obligation.
