*** JOB DESCRIPTION***

Specific duties and responsibilities include, but are not limited to the following:

Must possess the ability to independently conduct psychosocial assessments and provide treatment to a wide variety of individuals from various socio-economic, cultural, ethnic, educational, and other diversified backgrounds.

Provides evidence-based counseling and or psychotherapy services to individuals, groups, and families.

Provides consultation services to other staff about the psychosocial needs of patients and the impact of psychosocial problems on health care and compliance with treatment.

Evaluates own practice through participation in a professional peer review case conference or other organized means.

Uses computer software applications for drafting documents, data management, and tracking, especially those programs in use by DoD.

Uses medical and mental health diagnoses, disabilities, and treatment procedures to include acute, chronic and traumatic illness/injuries, common medications and their effects/side effects, and medical terminology.

Implements evidence based treatment modalities in working with individuals, families and groups who are experiencing a variety of psychiatric, medical and social problems to achieve treatment goals.

Establishes treatment plans as required over the course of therapy.

Demonstrates a working knowledge of professional standards and ethics regarding the delivery of clinical social work services.

Applies social work procedures and techniques in the evaluation and treatment of

psychological/psychiatric disorders.

Consults with medical personnel, legal authorities, military commanders and school districts, as required.

Maintains accurate and current notes in the medical records of all patients seen, as appropriate, and produces reports of evaluation and/or treatment, as required.

Performs other duties as assigned.

CONDITIONS OF EMPLOYMENT:

Fully licensed Clinical Social Worker. Must be credentialed/privileged mental health provider (social worker) proficient in the use of evidence-based therapy methods.
