

CONDITIONS THAT ARE DISQUALIFICATIONS FOR APPOINTMENT IN THE UNITED STATES
PUBLIC HEALTH SERVICE COMMISSIONED CORPS (USPHS) *

1. Diabetes Mellitus: history and/or presence of Type I, Type II, or gestational diabetes mellitus.
2. Impaired glucose tolerance /pre-diabetes.
3. Abnormal uterine cervix Pap smear results.
4. Presence of Human Immunodeficiency Virus (HIV) or antibody.
5. Acute or chronic viral hepatitis .
6. Syphilis (untreated).
7. Dental disorders that do not meet USPHS accession standards.
8. Hypothyroidism (untreated).
9. Tuberculosis (untreated latent or active tuberculosis).
10. Abnormal liver function studies.
11. Abnormal blood counts (white or red cell; platelets) that do not meet USPHS accession standards.
12. Abnormal cardiac rate, rhythm and/or conduction in the presence of organic heart disease; presence of pacemaker or implantable defibrillator.
13. Impaired hearing and/or abnormal inner/outer ear structure(s) that do not meet USPHS accession standards.
14. Impaired vision and/or abnormal eye structure(s) that do not meet USPHS accession standards.
15. Pregnancy and the Post-partum period (until either 43 days post-vaginal uncomplicated delivery or 56 days uncomplicated post-Caesarian section delivery).
16. Overweight or underweight conditions that do not meet acceptable limits of USPHS accession standards.
17. Dyslipidemia.
18. Abnormal urinalysis results (e.g. pyuria, hematuria, proteinuria)
